Dear colleagues,

I am pleased to read your paper entitled: Exploring Perceptions of Sexual Empowerment Among Heterosexual Black Women in Braamfontein, Johannesburg, and I'd like to congratulate you on the work you're presenting here. I was particularly interested in the issues addressed, and in this perspective, I have a few observations to make:

- 1. In your introduction, could you update the first bibliographic reference? You cite (Erchull & Liss, 2014) to show that sexual empowerment has become a matter of concern; Ten years later, is the subject still a concern?
- 2. In the introduction, would it be possible to cite a more recent bibliographic reference when justifying the study in South Africa, as you cite (Gqola, 2015)? The reality may have changed almost 10 years later.
- 3. Could you, at the end of the introduction, clearly state what the purpose of the study is and outline the article?
- 4. If possible, could you justify why the study sample includes only heterosexual black women between the ages of 22 and 30?
- 5. In the methodology, is it possible to specify the themes that were discussed during the interviews?
