Review of: "Do Not Resuscitate Practices in ICU: A Descriptive Study"

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1. Explicitly state the method for selecting the $n=77$ DNR patients (likely a subset of the 168 fatalities) in the **Methods** section.
2. Include the average **APACHE IV score** for the DNR cohort in Table 1 and the Results.
3. Ensure the top three diagnoses in the text match the counts in **Figure 1** and provide an accurate percentage based on $n=77$.
4. Clarify the significant difference in the **Discussion** for the high proportion of post-CPR DNRs.
5. Strengthen the discussion regarding the ethical tension of the DNR being a "pure medical decision" versus the best practice of family involvement/notification.
