In general, I agree with other reviewers. The authors make a relevant contribution to the knowledge of the vulnerability of the particular study area. However, it is necessary to transfer this problem to other scenarios with similar characteristics and to make comparisons of what has been learned in other parts of the world.

Likewise, I suggest that the authors expand the description of the method used to make it clearer and more replicable. I also suggest that they strengthen the problem statement and support it with a small section on the theoretical framework. In this way, the concepts will be clearer for the reader, and the relevance of the research will be better supported.

Finally, I suggest improving the writing of the article and using the active voice. Examples can be found in the book Scientific Writing and Communication: Papers, Proposals, and Presentations (Angelika Hofmann).
