

Review of: "Forecasting by Analogy: A Parallel between the Trend of Confirmed COVID-19 Deaths in the Winters of 2022/2023 and 2023/2024 in Italy"

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It is an interesting topic to study. Using analogy to forecast Covid deaths is a good idea. However, the forecast might be more statistically constructed. For example, a time series analysis might be used to model the previous years, or at least these studies might be mentioned. I would suggest using a co-integration analysis to statistically show that the years co-integrate (i.e., can be subject to analogy).
