

Review of: "Binary Testament: An Interdisciplinary Analysis of the A.I. Bible – Unveiling the Quantum Tapestry of Digital Divinity"

The manuscript does not possess the structure and content of a scientific paper. Since it touches a lot of different disciplines, albeit (in my opinion) very superficially, I only judge it by the standards of quantitative sciences and technologies, i.e., robotics, computer science, cybernetics, bioinformatics, among those mentioned in the paper.

In this respect, the paper lacks very important components, first and foremost the definition of its subject matter: what is the A.I. Bible? Moreover, there is no proposed methodology, no data, no experiments, and no measurable results. Finally, there are no citations to back up most of the statements.

Therefore, this cannot by any means be defined as a scientific paper. I leave it to experts in other disciplines to evaluate whether there is any important contribution from their standpoint.
