The article touches on a topic of great importance for the field of mental health, such as diagnostic criteria, its main contribution is to generate greater social visibility within the community of psy professionals about the value of parenting and the effects of parental styles on children's mental health. It is well structured, the narrative is clear and straightforward, the bibliographical references are adequate. However, it lacks a greater connection of some of the propositions of the paper. For example, what is the connection between the new parental styles and the main argument of the article? Or what is the point of comparing Western and Eastern parenting styles? Also, the paper would benefit in its analysis from a review of anthropological studies in mental health, especially those that address the problem of the construction of psy diagnoses.
