Given that the Altman Z-Score is a relatively straightforward model, it would be beneficial to provide a more detailed analysis rather than simply showing the calculations' results. The data presentation would enhance the reader's understanding of the research and its implications.

The conclusions section could be more extensive. More managerial implications and future research should be depicted.
