It has a significant number of bibliographic resources that enrich the text and reinforce its argumentative structure. It may be interesting to conceive in the text a space to explain the territorial problem that former guerrillas face due to their isolation and lack of infrastructure, as well as to mention the geographical dimension of the area of influence of FARC-EP and the dependence it has on a poorly industrialized agricultural sector connected to the main distribution centers of the country. Future research can be enriched with concrete data on the economic growth of these areas, as well as with development data that will allow you to verify whether the economic and social reintegration objectives established in the commitments of the Peace Agreement are being met.
