Title: The title is too long, and I think the author(s) should rephrase it to better show what the paper addresses. Repetitive words (e.g., Farmhouse Economic Economic Model) should be avoided.

Abstract: The abstract should, only if needed, provide a brief intro to the study. Then, state the objective, data collection and analytical method(s), results/findings, and conclusion with recommendations, if any. This structure would allow readers to have a detailed abstract of the study.

Introduction: Author(s) should provide citations in the second paragraph. Also, in the introduction, the authors should clearly define their research problem or objective for better conceptualization of their paper. There should be a conceptual framework for the research also. We should also know about similar studies that have been conducted either in the region or elsewhere and their findings.

Research area and methods: Author(s) should provide citations for all data presented in terms of location, population, agricultural activities, economic status, etc. The authors need to justify how they came about the 80 households selected. What principles guided their selection of households and research participants? How was the data collected? What population constituted the research?

Results & Discussion: The results should be juxtaposed with other results/findings in the literature.

Conclusions: The author(s) should base the conclusion on the findings from their study.

References: The author(s) should provide more citations. Also, select a reference style and use it uniformly throughout the study.
