

Review of: "Either you know or you've gotta believe"

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That's an interesting and convincing paper. On the rhetorical side, maybe the abstract overstates a bit: what is this "other line" of argument? All alternative accounts reviewed argue that belief is more than knowledge, so it's not really a new line (only a congruence). Maybe the paper should be more developed towards the end, otherwise it looks more like a state of the art than an original contribution. Even the section that is supposed to bring novelty merely cites yet another author...
