The manuscript presents an extensive overview of sunlight exposure knowledge and practices among mothers attending PNC and immunization clinics at Debre Tabor Comprehensive Specialized Hospital (DTCSH) in Northwest Ethiopia. The study utilized a cross-sectional institutional-based design and a structured questionnaire to evaluate knowledge, practices, and associated factors concerning sunlight exposure among participants.
