The manuscript is of local interest, and the data supporting the study seem to be adequate, although the frame of reference for both its origin and its treatment is not explicitly mentioned. In my opinion, this section should be highlighted. The problem is not described in a comprehensive manner. I would like to comment that climate change does not have a greater or lesser regional impact, but that the exacerbation of its effects depends on the preventive actions taken to mitigate them. The work should be enriched with published contributions that give a fair dimension of both the region and the expected effects and their consequences if they are not addressed. It seems to me that the work lends itself to substantial improvement.
