

Review of: "[Case Report] Acquiring Walking with Lower Leg Prosthesis by Passive Shoulder Blades and Improved Trunk Range of Motion: A Case Report"

The proposed article presents a case report of a patient with a lower thoracic vertebral deformity who performed regular rehabilitation, improved the thorax range of motion, and achieved walking with a lower leg prosthesis.

Here some comments and suggestions:

- The abstract should be improved since it appears to be a case report of the patient, it should be divided into: the reason for writing, problem, methodology, major findings and implications and significance of the study, and main conclusion.
- The introduction should be divided into the main problem, context, current studies evaluating similar findings, and the contribution of the article. Why is this article relevant, which is the main contribution compared with other similar studies?
- Results should have a graphical illustration of the outcomes of the study. All of the scales, tests, etc... should be mentioned before in a methodology. How are you going to present your results, it should be in the same order as your results.
- The discussion should analyze your results at the beginning to understand the importance of the work, and as you analyze the results you can add more studies with similar findings or compare how this study differs from the others.
- Figures should be in a results section and explained in detail to better understand the patient's condition.
