Bothriocephalosis is a mammalian cosmopolitan intestinal parasitosis. In addition to nonspecific digestive problems (nausea, abdominal pain, lack of appetite), bothriocephalosis provokes an anaemia caused by vitamin B12 deficiency that resembles Biermer anaemia (anaemia characterised by abnormally large red blood cells).
