- 1. There are more concepts (including the new ones) which are not defined in the draft and used untidy.
- 2. The author had more personalized the work, the scientific publication must be Unpersonalised.
- 3. The redaction style is so hard, not fluent for the public or scientific community. I think that the author must use professional software for its translation.
- 4. The draft discusses more the result from previous research than it presents and discusses the ones from the interview made in Salamina (No precision of the sample)

The others remarks are incorporated directly in the draft body.

Hence, this article can be accepted with major corrections for its publication.

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
