The authors in this paper explore the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, its impact on public health, the economy, education and social dynamics, and its response to subsequent pandemics. It also discusses necessary precautions and a survey-based study on the cyclical nature of pandemics.

The paper is weak from an experimental point of view. The structure of the questionnaire is not well understood, and it would be appropriate for the graphic representation to be shown differently, for example, using a wad or pie chart where the percentages are more easily deduced. Although the topic is of great interest, in my opinion, the empirical analysis should be extended.

The study of the literature could be deepened in the various sections. In my opinion, the paper deserves a minor revision.
