We agree with your opinion, but your opinion that "surgical treatment for asymptomatic papillary microcarcinoma and RFA for primary thyroid cancer may also be true excessive treatment." still needs further discussion. Asymptomatic PTMC patients may already have lymph node metastasis and extrathyroidal extension, and require standardized surgical treatment. Meanwhile, RFA can not be used as a treatment for primary thyroid cancer. Therefore, RFA theatment of thyroid cancer cannot be considered as excessive treatment.

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
