The study is a robust and comprehensive examination of personality judgments based on facial features using an online experiment with a large sample. The methodological rigor of the study is evident, with adequate reliability across all variables and a sophisticated data analysis approach, including principal component and hierarchical cluster analysis. The five-dimensional psychological space derived from personality-descriptive characteristics offers a differentiated alternative to the traditional valence-dominance model. The integration of both dimensional and typological approaches is a notable strength and enables a more comprehensive understanding of face perception. However, the study could benefit from more clarity on the practical implications of these results.
