

Review of: "An experience of global higher education and university autonomy in Viet Nam: A case study of Ton Duc Thang University in Ho Chi Minh City"

The manuscript provides an understanding of the practice of education internationalization and university autonomy at a Vietnamese public university. This makes the manuscript interesting. I was intrigued by the original survey excerpts and saw the potential for development of the manuscript if the authors could analyze these excerpts thoroughly.

The authors have much to do to improve the quality of the manuscript. The authors can consider the following suggestions.

- (1) Restructure the content of each subsection to highlight the core content that the authors want to convey. The manuscript also needs to be written in a more concise manner.
- (2) The manuscript mainly deals with the internationalization of education, but does not focus on university autonomy.
- (3) A research methods section needs to be added to the manuscript.
- (4) The manuscript should provide more significant research findings.
