

Review of: "Nigeria's Implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals"

The review of SDGs by the authors in their manuscript "Nigeria's Implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals" presents a compelling case for the SDGs as they pertain to Nigeria. The authors have provided a comprehensive overview of all 17 goals, and specific issues that can be applied to Nigeria moving forward. Granted that these socioeconomic concerns, however, development to a certain extent can be achieved by technological means, perhaps by collaborations. Overall, it is a nicely documented article; however, I would like to make two recommendations.

1. Provide sources for the data mentioned (although the authors have mentioned that it is a review of reviews drawn from existing literature and relied heavily on 2017 NVR data). If the data is reproduced, the authors should provide that in the acknowledgement that the data is reproduced with permission.
2. Provide articulation of technological means that can enhance addressing some of the gaps, especially in a period where automation and artificial intelligence are applied at very basic levels.

Recommendation: Publish with minor revisions.
