- 1. Including a discussion on the trend and prevalence of malaria in Nigeria. The fundamental independent variable in this article is the health outcome (incidence of malaria, IOM), but the article focused only on health expenditure (health input).
- 2. In the model specification section, the authors should tell us, in specific words, the proxy used for health outcome.
- 3. The authors can also justify the choice of using the ARDL technique.
