- 4. After major revision, the paper can fulfill the expectation of the target audience.
- 5. It would be better to incorporate practical implications along with academic outcomes.
- 6. Develop the conclusions section to include the unique contributions of the paper.
- 7. The language of the paper needs careful proof editing. The paper should be rejected if the case authors are not serious about the revision and the language of the paper.
