The writers have done an excellent job of providing their findings in an understandable and succinct way. The results are presented and interpreted with clarity, and the methods section is well-written and easy to read. The discussion part does a great job of placing the findings in the perspective of the larger body of literature, and the conclusions are valid and solidly supported by the evidence. Overall, the manuscript is well-written and executed.

A few concerns have been stated below which the authors can consider looking at.

- 1. Multiple logistic regression could be done to show the strength of the relation between the independent and dependent variables.
- 2. Exclusion criteria: Patients who took anti-protozoan drugs before the data collection period were excluded. Was there a limit in terms of the number of months the drug was taken before the data collection?
