When receiving a patient, the first step is the physical examination, complemented by vascular Doppler ultrasonography tests. However, the specific parameters evaluated by ultrasonography are not mentioned. What exactly is being sought?

It is suggested to be more specific in the descriptions regarding the diagnosis with Doppler ultrasonography. Avoid mentioning that an earlier diagnosis could also provide new insights into the pathogenesis of varicocele and associated male infertility.
