

Review of: "Weathering changes – livelihood adaptation to weather shocks in rural India by disadvantaged social groups"

Livelihood adaptation is crucial for the sustainable survival of vulnerable groups, especially when facing risks. In the context of climate change, especially when extreme weather events occur frequently, studying livelihood adaptation is a very good research topic. Therefore, research has social value and practical significance.

The suggestions are as follows :

1.The dependent variable is Δ MIGRATION, which is not completely consistent with the research topic of "livelihood adaptation". Going out to work or migrating is one of strategies for "livelihood adaptation", therefore, the paper lacks evidences of the practical connection between migration and livelihood (increasing income) in existing data. It is recommended to supplement and improve the evidence of the relationship between the two; And make the research highlight the theme of livelihood adaptation.

2.The coefficient symbols in formulas (1), (2), and (3) have different meanings, and it is recommended to use different symbol forms to represent them.
