

Review of: "Gender effects on outcomes of psychosomatic rehabilitation are reduced"

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The article is clear and well written, it addresses an interesting topic.

Future research may deepen the differences among groups of different ages, with particular attention to the elderly above 75 years old. Indeed, some studies suggested that physical outcomes may vary according also to the reported depression levels (Balestroni G. et al., 2020) and in different way for male and female gender, with worse outcomes for the latter (Panzeri, Komici, et al., 2021). Gender effects on physical and psychological rehabilitation is an intriguing topic still deserving further attention.
