Manuscript presented is very interesting, well-written, and covers a useful and timely clinical topic. I've only minor comments:

- 1. In the introduction section, authors should add some data about the most common psychiatric comorbidities of BD. Such comorbidities (as stated after) could be responsible for the diagnostic delay of BD.
- 2. On page 7/12 ("misdiagnosis"), the quote "...leading to a misdiagnosis of major depressive disorder for individuals only presenting with depressive symptoms" should be rewritten in a clearer way. If a patient presents only depressive symptoms, actually, the adequate diagnosis IS Major Depressive Disorder.
- 3. On page 8/12, the "complex nature of BD" essentially is overlapping with "misdiagnosis." The two paragraphs could be merged.
