

Review of: "Women in Slum, Risking Their Safety to Access and Usage of Basic Sanitation Facilities-A Literature Review"

Review comments

General comments

It is very interesting to have a manuscript that focused entirely on the safety and wellbeing of women especially those residing in urban slums. I commend the Authors for their efforts. I have some remarks to make which may necessitate some changes in the manuscript before it could be accepted for publication.

Authors should take note of the following observations

1. One may not know whether the manuscript is a systematic review or a review of literature. Authors should review the manuscript in the light of this information and also refer to Journal guidelines for appropriate guidance.
2. Irrespective of the review that the Authors adopt, the methodology of the review was not adequately explained. There was no mention of the Search strategy and the indication for including or excluding articles was not explained also. It will be good to indicate whether the focus of the manuscript is on global, regional or country situation.
3. The abstract does not have the same focus as the body of the manuscript. The methodology and study findings were not fully expressed in the abstract.
4. The abstract and the body of the manuscript did not include a conclusion section.
5. Authors should ensure that references and referencing style conform to Journal guidelines.
6. The manuscript should be reviewed critically for errors of grammar. These should include the title of study and the abstract.
