Review of: "Host-Guided Data Placement—Whose Job Is It Anyway?"

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First of all, I would like to congratulate the authors on this research. The manuscript is quite interesting and has some value. I would just like to make a few observations and suggestions for the authors to consider:

1. The first comment concerns the level of English, which, in my opinion, should be improved.
2. Maybe it could be useful to cite or read the following paper on a similar topic: Borghesi, M., Zambelli, C., Micheloni, R., & Bonnini, S. (2023). Modeling 3D NAND Flash with Nonparametric Inference on Regression Coefficients for Reliable Solid-State Storage. *Future Internet*, 15(10), 319.
3. It could be more precise to write the sources of the figures reported in the paper.
4. I think that the manuscript has a somewhat chaotic structure. For example, the titles “Why not rewrite the application?” or “What about a filesystem?” and so on... are they new sections or subsections? It is not very clear.
5. In my opinion, the scientific contribution of the paper should be emphasised more.
6. Perhaps the conclusions are a bit too short; they should be more detailed, and it could be more precise to add a few lines on future developments regarding the topic.

Finally, I would like to thank you for the opportunity to review and comment on this research, and addressing the abovementioned aspects can strengthen this investigation.
