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Well-written and well-argued article. The topic is exciting and rare. The author describes a case of a surgically treated cystic cyst.

The pathology is rare, and I think a table could be added with all the cases described in the literature in the last 10 years. Considering the rarity of the pathology, I would insert a figure or a table to describe Todani's classification. In the description of the case, I would also add the year to the date of the tests performed (to improve reading in the future).

After these corrections, the article could be considered for publication.
