Review of: "Strengthening COP Meetings through Cross-Sectoral Thematic Convergence and Highlighting Health in COPs"

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Thank you for the opportunity to review this manuscript. It provides a good overview; however, I have a few comments that reflect on its content:

1. The paper focuses on climate and health; however, after contextualizing what has been developing across COPs, it focuses mostly on research and education. Other areas, such as climate financing in health, would be extremely relevant to further develop. Can you provide a section on climate financing and specific examples of climate financing strategies that could be included in the manuscript?
2. I would appreciate seeing a contextualization of the health in all policies vs. health for all policies perspective, and how this can improve health representation at COPs, including civil society and governmental health representatives.
3. A stakeholder mapping of main actors in climate and health would be interesting to display, along with the different power dynamics among these in COPs. What specific stakeholder groups or representatives should be highlighted in the stakeholder mapping to enhance understanding of power dynamics?
4. I feel the manuscript would benefit from a "looking ahead" section, discussing what can be further done in future COPs, and making a reflection on what has been put out for COP30 in the health topic. What specific actions or goals should be proposed for COP30, and what specific focus areas for climate and health?
