The section about literature review, about methodology, and about results should be made more visible and should be separated from each other.

A paragraph or a subchapter about how other researchers have linked economic problems (and what economic problems) with culture would be interesting.

A chapter should be dedicated to described the applied methodology in more detail (e.g. how many persons were selected to be interviewed, what was the reason for choosing snowball sample, from which part(s) of Greece were the participants selected, when were data collection realized).

When discussing the results, more attention should be paid on how the results were concluded from the interviews (like preparing tables describing how many of the interviewed persons believed this or that).
