

Review of: "Honorary Authorship in Biomedical Journals: The Endless Story"

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The author does focus on a very common and important topic. But the discussion does not go far enough. Academic cooperation is not equal to Honorary Authorship. The author overemphasizes the harm of ghost authorship, but neglects the importance of academic cooperation. Therefore, how to distinguish Honorary Authorship from contribution academic cooperation has become an urgent issue to be resolved. Although the author cites ICMJE's criteria, I feel that it is not applicable to all authorship. This is because each author has their own division of labor, and this standard is too harsh.
