1. The abstract is very brief. The abstract should be focused on (the objectives of the article, techniques used, important results, main contributions of the study).
2. Article title: The title of the article does not suit the content of the article.

The article includes an overview of quality standards.

1. The article includes paragraphs without citing their references.
2. The article does not include a clear methodology.
3. Conclusion: It has no concluding characteristics. The conclusions should be represented to reflect what the author concluded from the research, not representing the results.
4. There is no real literature review for previous studies in the same area. However, the article needs to review previous research and focus on the most important findings of the researchers.
5. The references are few and old.
