First of all, I sincerely want to thank you for giving me the opportunity to review the manuscript (Title **Assessing the Impact of a Group Intervention on the Mental Well-being of Undergraduate Healthcare Students**) and suggest changes in it. I have certain suggestions for the reviewers that will certainly help them improve the overall quality of the manuscript. These suggestions are as follows:

1. When ending a line with a citation, the full stop comes after the citation and not before it. For example, in the following statement: "**While mental illness affects everyone, young adults suffer more, as apparent from the fact that suicide is the second most common cause of mortality in the 15-29 age group globally. (Batty et al., 2018; Stallman, 2010).**" The full stop will come after the bracket, i.e., **2010**, And not before the bracket. Authors are suggested to correct this in the entire manuscript.
2. The introduction section should have the citations of recent papers rather than outdated ones.
3. The authors should explain how they have decided that a sample of 57 students is sufficient for the present study.
4. Authors should justify why the convenience sampling technique was used, as it has numerous limitations.
5. Authors are suggested to make a separate section for 'limitations and future research prospects' rather than incorporating the same under the heading 'discussion.'
