First of all I would like to thank you for the opportunity to review this article. I think the subject matter is quite interesting, however the article needs to be improved for publication.

In the introductory section, I think it would be necessary to add more contextualisation of the term anxiety as well as the perspective that this variable offers from different psychological currents.

Also, the sampling error has not been established - is the sample really significant of the total study population? Furthermore, an analysis of the normality of the sample has not been carried out. The degree of reliability of the instruments has not been added either.

Derived from the previous paragraph, the results cannot be considered reliable due to the fact that a proper reliability analysis has not been carried out.

I believe that all of the above are reasons for not being able to review the article any further, because if the data are not analysed correctly, the discussion is meaningless.

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
