The subject of the article is very relevant and the research work was well conducted. Despite this, I would like to make some recommendations:

- 1. I did not read in the manuscript about the informed consent form applied to interviewees, nor even about approval of the work by a research ethics committee, an essential step for research with human
- 2. I think that the literature review should be incorporated into the introduction and should be condensed. It is extremely extensive. Authors need to be more concise. The manuscript isn't a thesis
- 3. It could be interesting to structure the article into topics: introduction, objectives, methodology, results and discussion of results, conclusions and proposal. The objectives are described twice, one of which is in the methodology, which seems inappropriate.
- 4. It is not necessary to explain what is methodology, how the research problem is formulated, how to characterize a study, what is the objective of a study, what is population, whoever reads the manuscript knows these concepts.
- 5. All graphs and quantitative description of the study can be removed because they are not relevant. A sample of 9 individuals isn't representative. It makes no sense to calculate the average, standard deviation, among other things, of this universe. Simply describe the characteristics of the population studied. Focus on qualitative results bibliographic references need to be reviewed and updated. There are many recent publications that can contribute to the discussion of this manuscript.
- 6. Why were nine individuals interviewed? Why not 10, 11? How did you arrive at this number?
- 7. Bibliographic references need to be reviewed and updated. There are many recent publications that can contribute to the discussion of this manuscript. All references are very old.
