Review of: "Impact of Mass Distribution of Long-Lasting Insecticide Nets on Malaria Prevention in Lindi Region, Tanzania: A Quasi-Experimental Study"

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A well-written article. The article has an appropriate title, proper explanation of the methodology, analysis, and discussion. It has also discussed its limitations as well as the anticipation for future research. However, since it utilises a pre-post t-test, some of the potential covariates/confounding factors (examples like behavioural patterns that may expose the residents to the infection, nature of occupations) may not be ruled out. I suggest to the author, if possible, to suggest a more robust statistical analysis like GLMM or GEE for future research.
