4. Results and discussions:

- The results seem unclear, please add findings that are not only qualitative but need to include quantitative ones.
- Please add a discussion section.

5. References:

- Please correct inconsistent citations in the article. Like whether the author's name is abbreviated or not. Furthermore, I suggest to cite more recent articles.
- Everything cited in the manuscript must appear in the reference list and use the same format.
