The discussion must discuss problems systematically and comprehensively using operational methods.

## Conclusion:

It needs to be emphasized that the conclusion is to answer the error. It seems that medical healing according to Islamic doctrine, such as the cupping method, has not been elaborated. In fact, the bekan method is a healing method taught by the Prophet Muhammad SAW.

## Reference:

Many references are out of date. A maximum of 5 years of reference renewal is required for journal articles.

## Recommendation:

The article is accepted but there must be improvements according to the reviewer's suggestions.
