

## Review of: "State crisis theory: A systematization of institutional, socio-ecological, demographic-structural, world-systems, and revolutions research"

The paper analyses various theories of state crisis by integrating five broad literatures to develop a comprehensive system. The available literature on neo-institutionalism, socioecological systems, demographic-structural theories, world-systems approaches, and revolutions research were studied in detail including the nature of the state crisis, causes, preconditions, stages and consequences; however, the used methodology of data collection and analysis are not fully explained in the text. At the same time, the conclusion part does not capture all findings of the study and possible ways of their implementations.
