

Review of: "Demographic and Clinical Characteristics of Refugee Children Utilizing Healthcare Services of Türkiye (2021-2022): A Single-Centre Study"

The study is an important contribution to understanding the needs of health care services for refugee children (and their parents). Of course, it is only descriptive as it is mono-centric and limited to a certain time interval. Maybe that would be one point that could be a bit more emphasized, namely that the results are not overall representative. Only those who reached the corresponding centre in Istanbul were analysed. We do not know anything about those who didn't reach this centre. Nevertheless, some results such as Vitamin D deficiency and the high utilization of emergency centers, also in non-emergency cases, are important findings which may help in the future to build more adapted health care services for refugees.

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
