The topic is very interesting. The research process was not properly followed: Topic, abstract, aim, method, results, discussion, limitations and conclusion. The limitation of the study would have made this article more valuable. The type of the article and the purpose is not clearly defined. The methods of data collection and analysis are not explained in details. A Prisma Flow chart would benefit this study to indicate the number of the article included and excluded in data analysis. The corrections and additions required will strengthen the discussion of the findings. It appears as if the discussion is based on the authors opinions rather than the findings analyzed from the articles which were included. Revise the article with major changes and it will be worth publishing.

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
