Dear authors, It is important to review the name of the parasite. Use preferably Giardia duodenalis. Review the spacing between words and some sections that contain unclear information: fourth paragraph - symptoms; second sentence of the fourth paragraph of the introduction - confusing; third sentence of the fifth paragraph in the introduction - confusing; second paragraph of the discussion - confusing. Include that the technique used has very low sensitivity for Giardia cysts; end of the third paragraph of the discussion: insert especially in cases of release of already infectious cysts in feces.

It is important throughout the text to review the use of words such as "creatures," "subjects," "respondents." In the tables, include the total number of participants.
