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The case report presents a rare instance of a choledochal cyst arising from the cystic duct in an adult, effectively highlighting the diagnostic and therapeutic challenges associated with this uncommon condition. The manuscript offers a thorough clinical presentation and justifies the use of advanced imaging and surgical intervention. However, the language occasionally lacks a formal academic tone, with minor grammatical errors and some informal expressions that could be refined. The discussion, while comprehensive, could be more concise and focused by avoiding repetition and integrating comparative literature more explicitly. Additionally, further details on the surgical technique and laboratory findings would enhance the report's completeness. Overall, the report contributes valuable clinical insight but would benefit from polishing in language, clarity, and structure to meet academic standards.
