- -The topic is very interesting and challenging, yet the title is a little bit misleading. Title needs to be more indicative of the scientific content of the article. It should also include the name of the studied herb: Artemisia.
- -Authors need to include more data on the previous literature on genus Artemisia, whether preclinical or clinical to draw attention to its biological importance.
- Authors need to provide the botanical identity of the Artemisia species used in the mentioned cases, as well as the method of preparation of the herbal tea used.
- -Authors need to elaborate more on discussing the use of crude herbal preparations as opposed to the use of pure
 active constituents to support their point of view.
