For example, the sentence "However, a dishonest student usually becomes a dishonest student" does not make clear the level of education. It can be assumed that it refers to basic level pupils who become higher level students.

The article would gain more interest if a survey of a sample of higher education students was carried out, for example, in order to have some data of their own to analyze.
