

Review of: "The Impact of physical exercise and alcohol conditions on self-reported health among cancer patients? An analysis of the Health Information National Trends Survey 2019"

The idea of the manuscript shows novelty for the scientific community. Actually, there are few studies that show the effects of physical activity and alcohol consumption on cancer patients.

The title and the abstract show the objective and the results of the manuscript. However, some corrections and areas for improvement are presented here.

1. In the title, erase the question mark "?" and change it by "."
2. Erase any citation in the abstract section, specifically in methods.
3. The full text is ambiguous, and does not match what the title and the objectives say.
4. It would be better if you could give more information about the variable physical activity. How much minutes did they perform a week, if they met with the minimum minutes set by the World Health Organisation 2020, which type of exercise did they practise most (resistance, endurance...) and also time spent in sedentary behaviour.
5. Why did the authors state the level of significance at $p < 0.1$? This level is only accepted for biological and medical research papers.
6. As the other reviewers say, we encourage you to revise the manuscript and try to make it easy to understand.
