The author's extensive literature review is commendable, but there are a few shortcomings in the article. The objectives are too numerous, and logical coherence is lacking in the arrangement of the literature review. The research argument and research gap are not clearly addressed, and there is inconsistency in discussing data collection and analysis. The participants' details and the data collection tool are not mentioned. Instead of emphasizing the findings in the conclusion, the author should have highlighted the major findings followed by a discussion and conclusion. Additionally, the author could have proposed a context-specific social work intervention model to address the issue of domestic violence and its connection to alcoholism.
