- 1. Include a sentence that talks to the novelty of this study
- 2. Revise the last paragraph of your introduction, especially the last 3 (three) sentences.
- 3. The research gaps are not clearly indicated in the literature.
- 4. Thoroughly proofread your work to pick up small mistakes and rectify them, i.e. Under the study area section, the sentence before the last indicates that there is figure 3.1 in the study, but in the overall study there is no figure 3.1, there's figure 1 7
- 5. Improve your discussion by supporting it with more literature.
- 6. An improvement in the conclusion section is required. Do not just summarize your findings there but state your concluding remarks based on your findings. Conclude your article with a strong and memorable statement. This could be a thought-provoking idea, a call to action, or a restatement of the importance of your work. Remember that a well-crafted conclusion is a crucial part of your academic article. It should leave a lasting impression on your readers and reinforce the importance of your research. Make sure it ties together all the elements of your paper and leaves a strong final impression.

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
